# A TIMELESS PLACE WHERE YOU CAN STUDY AND WORK

The library was inaugurated in 1936. Since its creation, it has been contributing to the academic success of the residents of Cité internationale and of the students and academics community in Paris. Its languages center aims at facilitating the dialogues between cultures inside and outside the Cité internationale.

## COLLECTIONS

They are pluridisciplinary and meant in priority for Master's level students and academics. They are made of:

- 50 000 printed books
- 9 800 magazines
- 378 000 e-books
- 63 databases covering all academic disciplines
- Online archives related to the Cité internationale's history available on Gallica.bnf.fr

Please note: the printed collections can only be consulted on site.

## ONLINE LIBRARY

63 databases (specialised magazines, articles, scientific works, raw data, news...) are available on-site as well as in your houses' bedroom when connected to the Cité internationale's Wifi network: SpringerNature, British Medical Journal, Nature, Oxford University Press, Cairn, Dalloz, Lextenso...

Located on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the central library and completely renovated in 2021, the language centre offers you the opportunity to improve your French, Spanish, English or Chinese by taking part in free conversation groups, as well as learning up to 26 languages on your own.
