## A RENOVATED SPACE FOR LANGUAGES LEARNING

Located at the central library' 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, the language center has been recently entirely renovated. The language center's team is made of teachers of french as a foreign language. It is a comfortable space where you can learn or improve your language skills.

## CONVERSATION GROUPS AND WORKSHOPS

To learn a language, practice is key! Throughout the year, you can subscribe to the language center and participate for free to weekly conversation groups in French, English, Spanish, Chinese... The language centers' team also offers cultural workshops in French regularly.

## **SELF-LEARNING**

You would rather learn a language on your own? Choose from one of the 26 languages available for self-study at our fully-equipped workstations.

## COLLECTIONS

More than 100 language methods are available: general language, business language, grammar, oral expression, oral and writing comprehension, prononciation... Specific methods to prepare DALF, DELF, TCF, TOEFL and TOEIC are also at your disposal, as well as bilingual novels, magazines, newspapers, etc.

#### ACCESS

Enter the central library, show your proof of residence or proof of registration or register at the library, then take the stairs opposite the library's welcome desk.

#### **OPENING HOURS**

Mid-September to mid-June Monday and Thursday: 1pm - 9pm Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday: 1pm - 7pm Mid-June to mid-September

Monday to Friday: 12pm - 7pm

Closed at weekends and on banking holidays.

#### **ACCESS CONDITIONS**

As the language centre is part of the central library, the conditions of access are the same.

**Residents:** you do not need to subscribe to the library, but you will need to show a proof of residence when you enter the library in order to access the language center.

Students without a scholarship\*, academics\*, alumni\*: 3 € /day or 35 € /year\*\*

Students with a scholarship: 1 € /day or 16 € /year\*\*

**Other users:**  $7 \notin$  /weekdays,  $10 \notin$  on Sundays, or  $200 \notin$  /year External users must first register with the library and then go to the language centre.

\* Upon presentation of proof. \*\* Valid from the date of registration to 30 September 2024.
